The two properties on Washington Street in Salem are neighbours. Enter the properties on the path between the two gardens. Additional parking can be found across the street at the Potato Board parking lot.

Property A – 492 Washington St, Salem

Our garden is a ¼ acre riverside garden on the shore of the Irvine River. We have a mix of trees, shrubs, perennials and annuals, on the gently sloping terrain. Raised beds for growing cut flower, grown from tubers, seeds, corms, or bulbs adorn the edge of the river.

Property B – 486 Washington St, Salem

We have a gently sloping backyard garden on the shore of the Irvine River, located directly across from the Salem Park. The garden has several defined beds filled with early spring bulbs and a wide variety of annual flowers which have all been grown from seeds in-house, under lights.

Property C – 121 Halls Drive, Elora

Take York Street East, then right on Fisher St, then left on Halls Drive
This small garden in an Elora subdivision is packed full of perennials. There is interesting use of ground covers, lots of verbascum, Japanese maples, and trees for small spaces. An instant burst of colour in May is provided when plants are moved from the plant room and greenhouse.
Coleus, impatiens, and orange marigolds are the most dominant annuals. Lots of varieties of hostas and clematis, as well as tree peonies, add beauty to this garden.
Come, sit, and have a glass of lemonade.

Property D – Groves Memorial Hospital, Healing Gardens, Aboyne

To get to the Healing Gardens, take the Service Entrance at the traffic circle and drive down behind the hospital to the staff parking area. We have permission to park here during the Garden Tour.

The Grand River Agricultural Society's Healing Garden, behind Groves, is in full bloom and now features comfy Muskoka chairs. Gardens are maintained by volunteers of the Elora & Salem Horticultural Society and are much enjoyed by staff, physicians, patients and visitors.
